

## REGION III – LAKE REGION HUMAN SERVICE CENTER CHILD WELFARE SERVICES

### Summary of Services:

Licensing for Family foster homes, group homes and residential child care facilities, and licensed child placing agencies for foster care; foster care eligibility determination and payment; case planning and reviews (permanency planning); placement services including Interstate Compact on Placement of Children, independent living skills assessment, training and stipends. Child Protection Assessments, Child Protection Case Management, Child Fatality Review Panel, Institutional Child Protection, Children’s Trust Fund, Child Abuse and Prevention. Parent Aide, Prime Time, Intensive In-Home, Respite Care, Family Focus, Safety/Permanency Funds. Licensing, Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R), Tribal Consult, and Head Start.

### Major Sources of Federal and Special/Other Funds:

Federal funds consist of Title IV-E, Child Care, and TANF funding.
