<b>Evaluate</b>	To consider something in order to judge its value, quality, importance, extent or condition
<b>Potential</b>	Having possibility or likelihood of happening
<b>Enhance</b>	To improve or add strength, worth, or beauty to something
<b>Assessing</b>	To examine something in order to judge or evaluate it
<b>Assistance</b>	Help given or made available to another
<b>Visual</b>	Learning by seeing
<b>Auditory</b>	Learning through hearing
<b>Tactile</b>	Learning through touch

<b>Kinesthetic</b>	Learning through movement
<b>Frequent</b>	Happen often
<b>Sensory</b>	Relating to sensation and the sense organs; learning through the five senses
<b>Efficient</b>	Doing tasks in an organized and capable way
<b>Oral</b>	Expressed in spoken form instead of written form
<b>Conjunction</b>	Events or circumstances happening at the same time or the act of combining two or more things
<b>Diagnostic</b>	A test, assessment, procedure or instrument used to identify the nature or cause of something
<b>Interpret</b>	To find or explain the meaning or significance of something
<b>Processing</b>	To think through and understand

<b>Invested</b>	To give time, energy, or effort to an activity or project with the expectation of a benefit at the end
<b>Primary</b>	Ranked as most important or coming first in a sequence
<b>Impact</b>	The powerful or dramatic effect that something or somebody has
<b>Retrieval</b>	To recall information
<b>Manipulative</b>	An object you can use with your hands while learning
<b>Dialogue</b>	The words spoken by characters in a book, movie, or play, or a section of a work that contains spoken words. A formal discussion or talk between two or more people.
<b>Olfactory</b>	Used in smelling or relating to the sense of smell
<b>Integrating</b>	Making something open to everyone or fitting in with a group
