

# North Dakota 18+ Continued Foster Care Program

## 18+ Eligibility

North Dakota has expanded foster care services to allow for youth to remain in or return to foster care after age 18.

### Must meet one of the categories:

#### Education

Participate in high school, GED classes, college, tech/vocational school, etc.

#### Employment

Work at least 80 hours per month.

#### Preparatory Employment

Participate in programming that removes barriers to employment (Job Corps, etc).

#### Medical Condition/ Disability

Be unable to participate in education or employment due to a diagnosed medical condition or disability.

**If you want to remain in foster care and do not meet one of the above categories; talk to your case manager.**



## How To Participate

### *You must:*


1. Need continued foster care services.
2. Be between the ages of 18 and 21.
3. Have aged-out of foster care at age 18 or greater from County Social Services, Tribal Social Services or Division of Juvenile Services.
4. Qualify in at least one eligibility category (located on left panel).
5. Agree to and sign the 18+ Continued Foster Care Agreement.
6. Return to foster care within six months of your last discharge date.



## Continue In Care

If you are almost age 18 and are unsure about being ready to live on your own, tell your case manager! This is your life, let your voice be heard.

## Return To Care

18+ Continued Care is voluntary foster care. An agreement must be signed by three parties (agency, foster care provider, and you) in order to return to foster care.
