

JUST THE FACTS

Cuts, trims, and prepares carcasses and consumer-sized portions of meat for sale or for use in food service companies. Follows strict government guidelines for the handling and preparation of meat products.

This career is part of the Agriculture, Science and Natural Resources cluster Food Products and Processing Systems pathway.

A person in this career:

- Records the quantity and quality of meat received and issued.
- Receives, inspects, and stores meat upon delivery.
- Estimates requirements and requisitions or orders meat supplies.
- Wraps and weighs meat for customers.
- Collects money from customers.
- Shapes, laces, and ties roasts, using a boning knife, skewers, and twine.
- Prepares special cuts of meat ordered by customers.
- Places meat on trays in display counters.
- Cuts, trims, bones, or grinds meats, such as beef, pork, poultry, and fish.
- Cures, smokes, tenderizes and preserves meat.

Working Conditions and Physical Demands

People who do this job report that:

- You would often handle loads up to 50 lbs., sometimes up to 100 lbs. You will need a lot of strength at this level.
- Work in this occupation involves bending or twisting your body more than one-third of the time
- Conditions are very hot (above 90 F) or very cold (under 32 F)
- Work in this occupation involves using your hands to hold, control, and feel objects more than one-third of the time

- Integrated functionality - not multiple products like Explorer and Planner
