

Schools are responsible for transportation and supervision.

A career fair has been scheduled for students in grades 9-12. This is a "hands on" trades, technology, and health career fair. Under supervision, students will be able to participate in activities relating to a career at each booth. This includes some large construction equipment. Campus tours will also be scheduled. Students will rotate between tours and equipment.

Each school will have about 1 1/2 - 2 hours of scheduled time to attend. Who will attend: Target audience is 9<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grade students and students planning to enter the work force or to attend two years or less of post secondary training/education. Students must be supervised by school staff.

Who is the Region III & IV Fair Committee? It consists of Directors of Special Education Units, Vocational Rehabilitation Counselors, School Counselors, Area Career and Technology Centers, Job Service Representatives, Lake Region Special Education and Community Options.
