Mission: University of North Dakota Army ROTC will train over 100 Cadets per year to provide leadership in the United States Army.

ROTC is not a major, but you can take a Military Science minor through ROTC. Military Science classes can also count as elective credit; however, always verify credit acceptance with your advisor. When you enroll in ROTC, you will learn valuable leadership and managerial skills that will benefit you throughout your entire career.

ROTC offers to our Cadets summer adventure training: Nursing Internship, Culture Awareness, Language Immersion, Airborne, Air Assault, Mountain Warfare, and more.
