UPDATES FROM CTE

LEGISLATION - SCHOLARSHIP

**Amend and reenact section
15.1-21-02.5 of NDCC:**

Fulfilled any one unit requirement set forth in subsections 1 through 4 or 6 by completion, through an early entrance program, of a non-remedial postsecondary course offered for credit at an accredited institution of higher education which has a physical presence in this state;

SB2074: Relating to the scholarship eligibility of students enrolled in external experiences (Awaiting governor's signature)

SB2075: Relating to the North Dakota scholarship eligibility of students in accelerated programs (Awaiting governor's signature)

LEGISLATION - EDUCATION

AN ACT to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the NDCC,

Relating to the demonstration of proficiency in civics as a condition of high school graduation.

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 15.1-19-24 of the NDCC,

Relating to youth suicide prevention training (At least two hours annually).

AN ACT to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-16 of the North Dakota Century Code,

Relating to school district negotiations; and to amend and reenact sections 15.1-15-04 and 15.1-16-13 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to school district contract renewals and negotiations (Shortens the time to sign contract to two weeks).

~~**HB1283:** Relating to parental directives; and to provide an expiration date (Died in the House 4/13/15)~~

SB2088: Relating to authorization for the creation of a North Dakota education foundation, and to provide for a report to legislative management (Amended, House Appropriations Committee recommends do not pass; 4/13)


