

Linda Alsop is the Director of Deaf-blind Programs at the SKI-HI Institute at Utah State University in Logan, Utah. She has an MEd in Deaf Education and a BS degree in Special Education. Linda has been a classroom teacher of students with disabilities, as well as a teacher of students with hearing impairments. She has worked directly with children and youth who are deafblind and their families since 1989, in both early intervention and educational settings. She has developed numerous deafblind resources, training curriculum, and multimedia materials that are being used by families, professionals, paraprofessionals, and interveners throughout the United States. Currently, Linda directs the online USU Program of Studies in Deafblindness and the online USU/Hadley Program of Studies in Blindness. She also acts as a national consultant in deafblindness and is actively involved in national efforts related to intervener practices in the United States.
