

NEED HELP PAYING YOUR RENT?

You may qualify for Emergency Rent Bridge HELP.

TO QUALIFY, YOU MUST:

- Be experiencing economic hardship.
- Have a lease and limited resources.
- Meet the income limits.

STEPS:

1. Complete the online survey at <https://bit.ly/2zXLPHk>.

2. If you receive a preliminary approval, you can **show a copy** of your pre-qualification notification to your housing provider to confirm to them that you have applied for help.
3. **Complete the application process** by providing the required documents. *(After pre-qualifying, you will receive an email within 24 hours that explains the next steps.)*
4. The *Rent Bridge* staff will review your application. You be notified of your application status.
5. If you are approved, payment will be sent directly to your housing provider in the month you requested help.

NOTE: *Before the payment is made, your housing provider must verify their status as a vendor in the state of North Dakota's system. Providers should visit <https://bit.ly/2Wcj96l> for more information on how to register.*
