ND Rent Help

Provides rental and utility assistance and other housing supports.

WHAT HOUSING PROVIDERS NEED TO KNOW

- ND Rent Help replaced the state’s Emergency Rent Bridge.
- Up to 12 months of assistance is available with the option for extensions for extreme cases.
- Higher income levels are accepted, annual income up to \$80,000 for a family of four.
- Counselors are available to help with rent and utility assistance applications.
- Payments are processed weekly and sent directly to the Housing Provider.

TO RECEIVE PAYMENT

New Housing Providers

- If you have never registered as a housing provider with the ND Office of Management and Budget, register at <https://bit.ly/2yK2Zba>. Enter “COVID-ERB” in the Special Program Code area.
- Once you have received your Supplier ID and you have your renter’s Confirmation ID number (your renter received this number when he/she applied for assistance), follow the steps below for OMB Approved Housing Providers.

OMB Approved Housing Providers

- To request payment for rent that is due, click on the Housing Provider Payment Request link on ND Rent Help’s website, <https://portalapps.nd.gov/dhsps/emergency-rent-landlord/>.
- Follow the instructions on the screen.
- Payment will be made using the method selected (via check or direct deposit) when you registered as a vendor.
