**Governor's Committee on Aging to Meet September 24 in St. Michael**

BISMARCK, N.D. – The Governor's Committee on Aging is meeting Friday, Sept. 24, 2010, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. in the Red Willow Room at the Spirit Lake Casino and Resort near St. Michael, ND. The public is invited to attend.

Agenda items include discussion on qualified service providers of in-home services, education forums, the governor's proposed budget guidelines, the committee's work plan for 2011, which includes the aging and disability project, senior needs, and increasing the visibility of the committee. Other items include reports from the Silver Haired Education Association and Region III Aging Services.

The Governor's Committee on Aging is an advisory body for the Aging Services Division of the North Dakota Department of Human Services. The committee is comprised of 14 members appointed by the governor and focuses on issues and services impacting older North Dakotans.
