- The Fargo Regional Child Support Enforcement Unit will open at 1 p.m. today.

Minot

- North Central Human Service Center will open at noon.
- The Minot Regional Child Support Enforcement Unit will be closed until at least noon.

Williston

- Northwest Human Service Center will open at noon today.
- The Williston Regional Child Support Enforcement Unit will be closed until at least noon.

The Department's regional human service centers and child support enforcement units in Bismarck, Devils Lake, Dickinson, Grand Forks, and Jamestown will be open as usual from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. However, they may be operating with reduced staffing.
