BISMARCK, N.D. – The Governor's Committee on Aging will meet Friday, June 8, 2012, in Bismarck to discuss issues impacting older adults and the services and programs that help them. The meeting is from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. at Edgewood Vista, 3124 Colorado Lane, Bismarck, and is open to the public.

Agenda items include a report on the committee's budget and a report from the qualified service provider workforce development subcommittee. Committee members will also discuss the statewide uniform nutrition forum and the regional trainings, Northern Plains Conference on Aging and Disability, committee's outreach efforts and communications plan, and the Silver-Haired Education Association's selection process of delegates for the Silver-Haired Assembly.
