State Council on Developmental Disabilities to Meet June 13

BISMARCK, N.D. – The N.D. State Council on Developmental Disabilities will meet Thursday, June 13, 2013, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. (Central Standard Time) in the State Capitol, Fort Totten Room in Bismarck.

The council works to promote choice in services, independence, productivity, and inclusion for North Dakotans with developmental disabilities, and supports projects and activities that maximize opportunities in these areas for consumers and families.

The meeting agenda includes the appointment of a consumer advisory council member, current council budget report, 2014 state fiscal year budget, review of the council's state plan goals and objectives, the status of the 2014 requests for proposals, and reports from the executive committee, membership committee, and state plan committee. The council's executive director will provide a report, and several members will demonstrate an elevator speech. There will also be an opportunity for public comment and member announcements.
