**Council coordinating services for children with disabilities to meet**

BISMARCK, N.D. – North Dakota’s Interagency Coordinating Council will meet Wednesday, March 4, 2015, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. CST, via statewide video conferencing system sites.

The council advises the North Dakota Department of Human Services on the coordination of early intervention services for children with disabilities and children at risk of developmental delays or disabilities who are five years of age or younger.

At the meeting, members will hear reports on the Part C and Infant Development Program budget, developmental disabilities slots, and the general supervision work plan, as well as updates on Autism Task Force efforts, Medicaid eligibility for children on the intellectual disability/developmental disability waiver, the 2015 Part C Application Package, and the State Systemic Improvement Plan.
