North Dakota Problem Gambling Advisory Council to meet April 15

BISMARCK, N.D. – North Dakota’s Problem Gambling Advisory Council will meet Wednesday, April 15, 2015, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., at the North Dakota Department of Human Services’ Prairie Hills Plaza location, at 1237 W. Divide Ave., in Bismarck.

The public is welcome to attend. Attendees should enter through Door 2.

The council focuses on addressing problem gambling and raising awareness about gambling addiction, treatment, and resources.
