Council coordinating services for children with disabilities to meet

BISMARCK, N.D. – North Dakota’s Interagency Coordinating Council, which advises the North Dakota Department of Human Services on early intervention services for young children with disabilities, will meet Monday, Jan. 25, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., CST, via the state video conference system.

Council members will receive updates on annual performance report data and the state systemic improvement plan, and will review a Division of Early Childhood (DEC) Recommended Practices Video. The meeting agenda also includes reports on the Part C budget and Developmental Disabilities slots, a report by the Autism Task Force, and updates on membership, and general supervision.
