APRIL 12 WEATHER CLOSURE ANNOUNCEMENT: 6:30 a.m. Update

Department of Human Services offices in Fargo closed; offices in Jamestown and Valley City to delay opening until 10 a.m.

BISMARCK, N.D. – North Dakota Department of Human Services offices in Fargo will remain closed today, April 12, and department offices in Jamestown and Valley City will delay opening until 10 a.m. as the region recovers from the latest storm.

Affected offices include:

- **Fargo:** Southeast Human Service Center, the regional child support office and the vocational rehabilitation office in Fargo are closed today. Southeast's behavioral health crisis line can be reached at 701-298-4500 or 888-342-4900.
- **Jamestown:** South Central Human Service Center and the regional child support office will delay opening until 10 a.m. Clients can reach South Central's behavioral health crisis line at 701-253-6304 when the center is closed.
- **Valley City:** South Central's outreach office in Valley City will also delay opening until 10 a.m.
