Water damage temporarily closes agency's Off Main program in Fargo; some services are being moved to Southeast Human Service Center

BISMARCK, N.D. – Heavy overnight rainfall caused water damage and sewer issues at the North Dakota Department of Human Services' Off Main Program in Fargo, which provides specialized treatment and recovery services and supports to individuals recovering from both substance use disorder and mental illnesses.

Officials are unsure when staff will be able to resume serving clients at the satellite program, which is affiliated with Southeast Human Service Center and located at 1122 First Ave. N. in Fargo.

In the interim, medication management and related medical services will be provided at the human service center at 2624 Ninth Ave. S., and behavioral health team members will provide other services through outreach or on-site at the center depending on individual needs.
