An eligible household's adjusted income must fall within the eligibility limits listed below for the household size. The adjusted income of all members of an eligible household cannot exceed:

The asset limit requirement will be eliminated for the FY2018 heating season. Assets will no longer be considered in determining eligibility for the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program.
