The North Dakota Department of Human Services can assist individuals who need help addressing stress, anxiety and depression in healthy ways, or who may need assistance with food, heating, child care, and health care coverage. If things have reached a crisis, we can also help.

- **Crisis Help** – If you are in crisis, call our **confidential crisis lines** 24-hours per day, seven days a week or go to a regional human service center during business hours for immediate help.
- **Open Access (walk-in) behavioral health assessments** – *Walk-in during Open Access hours for mental health and addiction assessment and triage services, and if needed, get connected to help right away.*
- **Substance Use Disorder Voucher Program** – *Get help with cost of addiction treatment and recovery services from participating providers, if you qualify.*
