

The North Dakota Department of Human Services Field Services Area, which includes the eight regional human service centers and the North Dakota State Hospital, provides a range of behavioral health care for individuals with mental illness and substance use disorders.

- **Services provided by staff or through contracted providers include:** assessment, care coordination, medication management, home and community-based services, residential services, crisis beds and inpatient hospitalization and emergency services such as 24-hour client crisis lines and North Dakota State Hospital admission screening. A Mobile Crisis Service is available in the Fargo and Bismarck regions.
- **Crisis Help** – *If you are in crisis, call our **confidential behavioral health crisis lines** 24-hours per day, seven days a week or go to a regional human service center or one of their outreach offices during business hours for immediate help.*
- **Open Access (walk-in) behavioral health assessments** – *Walk-in during Open Access hours for mental health and addiction assessment and triage services, and if needed, get connected to help right away. Crisis walk-ins are always welcome during business hours, not just Open Access hours.*
