<p><b>Chronicity</b>                  Medical needs associated with the condition are long term or lifelong.</p>				
<p><b>Medical Management</b>                  Care requires periodic consultation by a medical or dental specialist or management by a multidisciplinary team.</p>				
<p><b>Complexity</b>                  Treatment of the condition requires two or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prescription medication</li> <li>• Special equipment, braces, prosthetics or supplies</li> <li>• Therapy (e.g.) occupational, physical, speech, or respiratory therapy</li> <li>• Related services (e.g.) developmental, educational, mental health, home health, family support, social, or nutritional services</li> <li>• Surgery or hospitalization</li> </ul>				
<p><b>Interventions</b>                  Effective interventions are available that have a reasonable probability of benefiting the individual by improving health and function or extending longevity.</p>				
<p><b>Seriousness</b>                  Condition greatly impacts child's life:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Condition affects activities of daily living</li> <li>• There is a high likelihood that the condition would have an impact if not addressed</li> </ul>
