

Adults in the Community in Need of PATH or Extended Care Services

Adults Age 18+
participating with Project for Assistance in Transition from
Homelessness (PATH)

1. If homeless or at imminent risk of homelessness and have a serious mental illness or a co-occurring serious mental illness and substance abuse disorder, referred to PATH Coordinator
2. Individuals, who are experiencing homelessness, are not required to complete the intake process.
3. Case management services are provided through the Extended Care Services Unit and other appropriate services offered at the HSC's (vocational rehabilitation, substance abuse, psychiatric, etc)
4. Once stabilized in housing and in agreement continued services, will be transferred to adult case management services

Adults Age 18+ in the community
(No prior involvement in HSC Services)

1. Complete Application for Services
2. Intake Process
3. Eligibility Determination
4. Assigned Case Manager if meet eligibility criteria, if not refer to other appropriate services (acute, substance abuse, psychiatric- medication, vocational rehabilitation)
5. Develop individual treatment plan (ITP)
6. Discuss available services in the community and HSC services;
 - a. Safe and Stable place to live (Housing)
 - b. Educational/Vocational Plan
 - c. Natural Supports
 - d. Avoidance of illegal/high risk behaviors
 - e. Access to physical and mental health services
 - f. Economic Assistance Programs
 - g. Life Skills Development
 - h. Consumer Advocacy
