

ND Title IV-E Prevention Services Provider Training Grant Application

The ND Title IV-E Prevention Services Provider Training Grant offering is intended to offset the cost of the training and/or certification that will enable a person to deliver an evidence-based service, such as may be required by each of the evidence-based models identified in North Dakota’s Title IV-E Prevention Services Plan, in accordance with the Family First Prevention Services Act (FFPSA).

The goal of the training grant program is to boost the availability of evidence-based services available to children and family across North Dakota.

The Department of Human Services is seeking proposals from entities that are organized to legally conduct business in the state of North Dakota, and

- Who are applying to support individuals who have appropriate credentialing to deliver identified services upon completion of the training that is the subject of the application; and
- Are able to provide evidence of willingness to serve in ND geographies where there is a demonstrated need not deemed fulfilled by existing providers; and
- Attest to their commitment to adhere to evidence-based practice standards and to deliver approved Title IV-E Prevention Services with fidelity; and
- Who intend to offer one or more of the approved evidence-based services as approved in the ND Title IV-E Prevention Services Plan in a geography(ies) where there is a demonstrated unmet service need that can be met by these services, for children and families for whom the Plan is designed to serve.

Examples of the ways these funds can be utilized by the Grantee:

- Training and professional development, as delivered by an approved training provider, as per the requirements of the FFPSA
- Travel and other allowable costs related to the approved training and development
- Technology costs to support the delivery of the identified service
- Background checks
