



Child Support Enforcement

Important Notice – Child Support Lien Registry Coming Soon

This notice is to give you information about a new enforcement tool that Child Support Enforcement (CSE) will begin using within the next few weeks.

Beginning March 1, 2012, CSE will have a **child support Lien Registry** on its Web site, www.childsupportnd.com. The Lien Registry is a list of individuals who owe past-due support that is being enforced by CSE. The Lien Registry will be available to be searched by interested parties, such as individuals who are thinking about buying property from a parent who owes past-due support and whose ability to transfer that property might be affected by a lien. As another example, the Lien Registry will be available to be searched by lenders who are considering making a loan to a parent with a past-due support obligation. In addition, since the Lien Registry will be a public site, it can be searched by anyone at any time.

If you owe past-due support, you can expect that your name and other information about you will appear on the Lien Registry. This is true even if you are making regular payments on the past-due support.

If you are on the Lien Registry, a child support lien is automatically created against some of your property in North Dakota.
