

CHILD CARE STABILIZATION GRANT

North Dakota early childhood providers are eligible to receive an operating support payment to help promote stable and sustained operations of child care in communities across the state.

Child care providers may use STABILIZATION funds to cover the following expenses

Personnel Costs for Paid Employees

- Health, dental, and vision insurance
- Scholarships
- Paid sick or family leave
- Retirement contributions
- Raising wages
- Professional development or training
- Premium or hazard pay, staff bonuses (including recruitment bonuses)
- Employee transportation costs to and from work

Rent, Utilities, Facilities, Maintenance, and Insurance

- Rent or mortgage payments (including late fees)
- Utilities (including late fees)
- Insurance (including late fees)
- Facility maintenance or improvements
- Building or updating playgrounds
- Renovating bathrooms
- Installing railing, ramps, or automatic doors to increase accessibility
- Removing non-load bearing walls to create additional space for social distancing

Personal Protective Equipment, Cleaning, and other Health and Safety Practices

- Equipment
- Supplies
- Services
- Training

Equipment and Supplies

- Safety protocols
- Technology to collect data

Goods and Services

- Food
- Diapers or toileting supplies
- Play and learning materials
- Safe sleeping environments
- Licensing fee
- Goods or services associated with meeting licensing requirements
- Goods or services associated with meeting QRIS requirements

Mental Health Services

- Mental health for staff
- Mental health for children

Paying for Past Expenses; Costs incurred after 1/31/2020 **AND** must have been licensed during time of the expense. May not be used for start-up costs.

- Rent/mortgage/facilities
- Personal protective equipment, sanitation, health and safety
- Equipment and supplies
- Goods and services
- Mental health services

Programs will be **REQUIRED** to report how funds were spent every 30 days prior to applying for the next month.
