**E0202RR: PHOTOTHERAPY LIGHT OR BLANKET**

Effective for dates of service 7/1/2010 and after ND Medicaid will no longer allow/reimburse a Home Health Agency for (E0202) Phototherapy (bilirubin) light *or blanket* with photometer.

ND Medicaid will continue to allow/reimburse Durable Medical Equipment (DME) suppliers for the rental (modifier RR) of E0202 – Phototherapy (bilirubin) light *or blanket* with photometer as per the ND Medicaid DME Manual guideline.

When billing E0202 RR, one unit = one day, rental is limited to 7 consecutive days per lifetime.

**BILIRUBIN LIGHTS: Prior authorization is required.**

Covered for the treatment of hyperbilirubinemia within the first 30 days of life and for a maximum of 7 consecutive days.
