### Public Information Meeting Notice - Missouri River Correctional Center (MRCC) Land Use and Planning Study

Notice is hereby given that the North Dakota Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (DOCR) will hold a public informational meeting on **Tuesday, March 4th, 2014 at 6:00pm in the Brynhild Haugland Room at the North Dakota State Capitol, 600 E Boulevard Ave in Bismarck**, regarding the Missouri River Correctional Center (MRCC) Land Use and Planning Study being conducted in accordance with Senate Bill No. 2015 as enacted by the Sixty-third Legislative Assembly of North Dakota.

At the meeting, the project team will discuss the feasibility and desirability of relocating the MRCC to a location near the Youth Correctional Center (YCC) located at 701 16<sup>th</sup> Ave SW in Mandan, and reusing the existing MRCC site located along the Missouri River at 1800 48<sup>th</sup> Ave SW in Bismarck as a public day use park.

- The purpose of the meeting is to gather public opinion about the study to be included in the final report to the North Dakota Legislature.
- The project team will provide background information about both the MRCC & YCC facilities and the populations they serve.
- The project team will discuss the process being used for the study and give a progress update including concept plans for each site.
