## FOSTER PROGRAM SUBSIDIZED EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT



DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE SFN 171 (7-2024)

Provisions of federal law allow the North Dakota Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to utilize Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) funds to develop and subsidize employment for recipients as an alternative to aid. The purpose is to use this method of assistance to enable the recipient to become employed and to offset some of the training-related expenses primarily in the area of staff time to train the new employee.

No subsidized employment participant may be assigned to fill any established, unfilled position vacancy resulting from a layoff, termination or otherwise involuntary reduction of workforce in order to fill the vacancy with a subsidized employment participant. This must be a new position for an existing employer or be virtually any position for new or expanding employers.

The Department agrees to reimburse the employer for wages, benefits, and the additional costs of employment related
taxes and insurance expended on the participant for a period of up to months.
The employer agrees to place the employee on the payroll at the regular market wage of not less than the current minimum
wage for this position. Providing the work performance is satisfactory, the employer plans to retain the employee within the

The employer is to submit a monthly reimbursement request form reflecting the agreed upon amount along with a copy of the participant's time and payroll record for that same time period to:
