Section 837 of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 requires, "State agencies to make available, upon request, to any federal, State, or local law enforcement officer the address, social security number, and (if available) photograph of a SNAP recipient if the officer furnishes the recipient's name and notifies the agency that the individual is fleeing to avoid prosecution, custody, or confinement for a felony, is violating a condition of parole or probation, or has information necessary for the officer to conduct an official duty related to a felony/parole violation."
