ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

I acknowledge that to be a licensed dealer in the State of North Dakota:

- A dealer is a person, partnership, association, or corporation in the business of buying, selling, leasing, or exchanging of aircraft or ultralight vehicles.
- Demo certificate instruction requirements are as follows:
 - Demo certificate will only be issued if an aircraft N-number can be assigned.
 - When a demo certified aircraft is sold, SFN 11630 (Purchaser's Certificate) must be completed and returned to the Aeronautics Commission (may be provided via email to ndaero@nd.gov or by mail).
 - ALL** aircraft added to inventory *after this application has been approved* are required to be reported to the Commission with required \$10 fee. Excise tax is assumed *unless* an exemption can be determined. To be exempt from excise tax, you must report every aircraft even if the aircraft is under your company name for a minimal time.
 - Demo aircraft can be used **ONLY** for demonstration flights to qualify for this dealer license. Flying aircraft for other than demonstration *requires* a state aircraft registration and excise tax. When the hours flown exceed fifty hours in the twelve-month period, the aircraft is presumed not to be a demonstration aircraft and the aircraft excise tax must be remitted to the aeronautics commission under chapter 57-40.5 unless upon satisfactory proof the aeronautics commission determines the aircraft is used exclusively for demonstration purposes.
- Inspection of the dealer's place of business and maintenance facilities may be required. If maintenance facilities are leased, include a copy of the lease with this application.
- Return your application and fee to the address listed below. A certificate will be returned to you as notice of action by the Commission.
- All dealer licenses expire December 31 of year issued. The deadline to renew dealer application is January 1.
