Students who are performing significantly below grade level can be referred for the following services at Washington:



## SYSTEM 44 READING/DECODING

Students in grades 3-5 can be referred for screening in the System 44 program. If it is found that they are in need of decoding intervention, they will receive intense instruction in the program 45-60 minutes per day, 5 days a week.

## MATH INTERVENTION

Do The Math, created by Marilyn Burns, is an arithmetic intervention for students in Grades 1 through 8+ who struggle in math. The program focuses on Number and Operations—the cornerstone of elementary mathematics instruction—and integrates computation number sense, and problem solving. Do The Math will help reach those struggling students who need it the most.
