*Gather Resources - Hunt for those hard to find lesson components and ideas*


*Co-Planning- Through conversation, collaboratively plan a lesson or a series of lessons that meet best practices.*

*Model Lesson- teacher to observe teaching and student behavior*


*Team Teaching- After planning, cooperatively, teach a lesson together.*
