As in past years, I will again be scheduling visits to each elementary building. Feedback from those visits tells me that it is helpful to have a scheduled day to be available. I will find a "home base" when I arrive and let you know where to find me. You may stop in to visit, invite me to your room, or schedule a specific time to collaborate. The Technology Integration Specialists will often be in the building at the same time. We hope that by partnering we can better answer questions and be available for support. The following are some roles teachers have found most helpful in the past.

Roles of support for buildings

- Instructional support (*visit classrooms and provide feedback, team and model lessons, brainstorm resources and technology options*)
- Curriculum support (*reading, science, social studies, math, health, music*)
- Classroom/learning support (*collaborate with staff on curriculum/students to problem solve solutions to concerns, collaborate on assessment and learning*)
- Teacher mentor (*offer support to staff with pedagogy, curriculum, classroom management*)
- Data support (*collaborate with staff around data and tie it to classroom instruction and student achievement*)
