

## **50080 School Psychology Standard**

North Dakota first adopted the National Association of School Psychologists (NASP) standards for the review of its programs in school psychology in 1996. The Education Standards and Practices Board (ESPB) reconfirmed this decision to use the NASP standards by adopting the latest NASP standards revisions at their December 1999 meeting. All North Dakota programs are required to demonstrate the use of performance assessments in their programs and to incorporate the use of current, appropriate instructional technologies.

Effective date March 2000, mandatory for visits March 2002.
