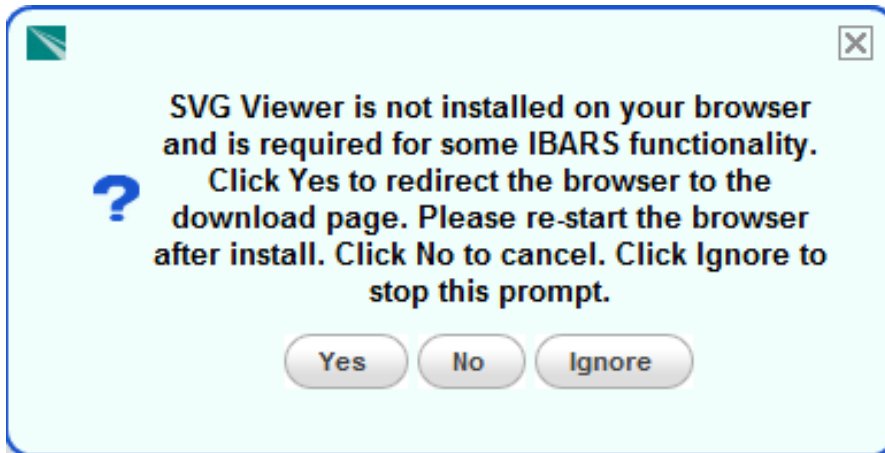



# IBARS:IBARS First Time Users

The following instructions are to be used as a step-by-step guide to connecting to IBARS for the first time if using version 7 or 8 of Internet Explorer (SVG's are handled correctly in other browsers).

## Click 'Yes' to redirect to the SVG Viewer download page



## Click 'Viewer Download' on the right side of the window

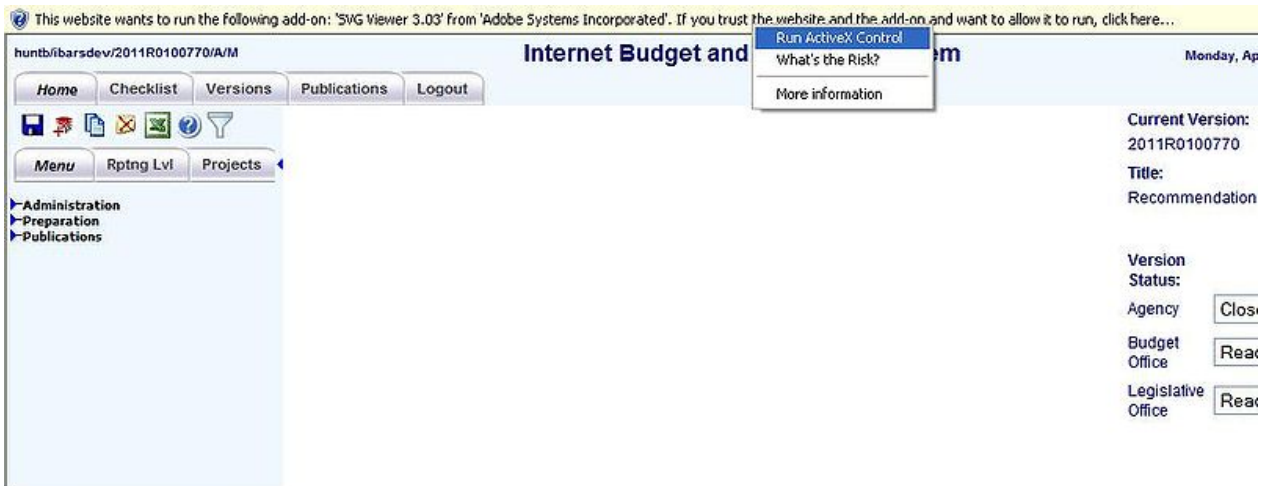
On prompt of security warning click 'Run'



## Complete the installation

Depending on the security configuration of your computer a series of prompts may appear requiring action. The following prompt may appear along with a 'yellow bar' security warning across the top of the page.

1. Click 'No' to the prompt
2. Right-click on the yellow warning bar and choose 'Run ActiveX Control'



3. If prompted, click 'Run'



Other 'yellow bar' security warnings may appear requiring the same process as above steps 2 and 3 . Once all necessary security warnings are bypassed no further action is needed.

## Additional Notes

If prompted to accept the licensing agreement for Adobe SVG Viewer from within IBARS at any time, click 'Accept'.
