## One vehicle roll over DUI Crash in Fargo

What: DUI Crash with minor injuries

Where: I-29 southbound at the 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave south exit

**When:** April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, at 2:45 AM (Central Time)

**Road Conditions:** Good

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Vehicle

Type of Crash: Roll Over

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol

Vehicle No. 1: 2018 Jeep Compass

Driver No. 1: Adhitiya Monger 19-year-old male from Fargo, ND Minor Injuries

**Restraints:** Seatbelt, front airbag deployment

**Charges:** DUI, and infraction possession of marijuana

**NARRATIVE:** The Jeep was travelling southbound on I-29. The driver (Monger) attempted to take the 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave south exit. (Monger) failed to stay on the roadway, and struck a DOT sign before leaving the roadway, entering the west ditch rolling his vehicle. (Monger) sustained minor injuries and was medically cleared by on scene paramedics prior to being arrested for DUI and transported to the Cass County Jail.
