Cass County injury crash

What: One vehicle injury crash

Where: Westbound Highway 46 milepost 96.5 (4 miles southwest of Leonard, ND)

When: April 9th, 2024 at 9:12 P.M. Central Time

Road Conditions: Dry asphalt **Weather Conditions:** Overcast

Crash Involvement: Vehicle left roadway and overturned.

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Ransom County Sheriff's Office, Leonard

Fire and Rescue, and Kindred Ambulance.

Vehicle No. 1: 2005 Jeep Liberty

Driver No. 1: Female, 21, Lisbon, ND- injured

Restraints: Seatbelt

Charges: Pending investigation

Vehicle No. 1: 2005 Jeep Liberty

Passenger No. 1: Male, 23, Lisbon, ND- injured

Restraints: Seatbelt **Charges:** None

Narrative:

The 2005 Jeep Liberty was westbound on Highway 46 when the driver left her lane crossing over the centerline into the eastbound lane. The driver overcorrected back into the westbound lane and drove into the north ditch. The vehicle continued through the north ditch then tripped and rolled. The vehicle came to rest on its roof in a nearby field facing east.

Both occupants were treated on scene by the Kindred Ambulance. The male passenger sustained serious injuries and was transported to Sanford in Fargo. The female driver sustained non-life-threatening injuries and was also transported to Sanford.



The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
