Cass County DUI injury crash

What: Injury crash

Where: Interstate 29 northbound, mile marker 56, 4 miles south of Fargo

When: April 14, 2024 at 11:51 p.m. CT

Road Conditions: Good, dry

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs. Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rear end (see narrative)

NARRATIVE: The Silverado was traveling northbound on Interstate 29 near mile marker 56. A travel trailer camper was stopped on the right shoulder of the northbound lanes due to mechanical issues. The Silverado drifted onto the shoulder, striking the parked travel trailer. The Silverado came to rest in the east ditch. The travel trailer came to rest on the east shoulder with debris across both lanes of the interstate. Traffic was slowed for approximately one hour while crews worked to clear debris and vehicles from the scene. The driver was charged with driving under the influence of alcohol, a Class B Misdemeanor.
