Williams Injury Crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: Highway 1804 mile marker 333 approximately 1 mile west of Trenton, ND

When: January 22, 2024, at approximately 11:55AM CST

Road Conditions: Wet, Snow covered.

Weather Conditions: Cloudy, snowing in the area

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs Tractor

Type of Crash: Angle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Williams County Sheriff's Office, Williston

Ambulance, Trenton Rural Fire Department, Williston Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2009 Freightliner

Driver No. 1: Michael McGrath, 58 year old, Benton, AR - Uninjured

Restraints: seatbelt in use

Vehicle No. 2: 2020 Kubota M5

Driver No. 2: Lester LaDue, 81 year old male, Trenton, ND – Serious life-threatening injuries.

Restraints: Unknown

NARRATIVE:

The Kubota was traveling eastbound on Hwy 1804 at slow speed. The Freightliner was traveling eastbound behind the Kubota and 2 other vehicles. The two vehicles passed the Kubota in the left lane. The freightliner began to pass the Kubota in the left lane as well. The Kubota began to turn left onto 147th Ave NW. The Kubota was struck by the Freightliner. Both the Kubota and Freightliner came to rest in the north ditch. The driver of the Kubota was transported by ambulance to CHI St. Alexius and sustained serious injuries in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation of the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
