Stutsman County Injury Crash

What: One vehicle injury crash

Where: Westbound I-94 mm 224 (6 miles west of Medina, ND)

When: January 9th, 2024 at 9:05 P.M. Central Time

Road Conditions: Dry asphalt

Weather Conditions: clear skies

Crash Involvement: Semi left roadway striking guardrail.

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Medina Fire and Rescue, and Medina Ambulance.

Vehicle No. 1: 2018 International truck

Driver No. 1 52yr-old male of Bismarck, ND- injured

Restraints: None

Charges: None

Narrative:

The 2018 International truck was westbound on I-94 when the driver had a medical event causing him to lose control. The semi left the roadway and entered the median striking the guardrail. The semi came to rest facing southeast in the median. The driver, 52yr-old male, was treated on scene and transported to Jamestown Regional Medical Center for further care. The 52yr-old male sustained non-life-threatening injuries as a result of the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
