of the roadway before coming to final rest facing west after striking an office/apartment building.

The pedestrian sustained life threatening injuries and was transported from the scene to Mercy Hospital by Barnes County Ambulance before being flown to Fargo by Sanford AirMed. No occupants inside the building were injured. All vehicles involved sustained moderate damage. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
