North Dakota Insurance Commissioner Adam Hamm (Commissioner) has determined as follows:

1. The Commissioner has authority in this matter pursuant to N.D.C.C. title 26.1.
2. Family Mutual Insurance Company, FEIN 45-0453425 (Respondent), is a county mutual insurance company authorized to do business in North Dakota.
3. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over Respondent and the subject matter of this Consent Order and this Order is made in the public interest.
4. The Department conducted a financial examination of Respondent covering the time period January 1, 2004, through December 31, 2009.
5. According to information received by the North Dakota Insurance Department, during the time period of January 1, 2009, through July 31, 2010, Respondent insured property beyond its authorized territory of operation. Respondent's conduct of accepting applications and premium payments and insuring property outside its territory constitute violations of N.D.C.C. § 26.1-13-15. For this violation, Respondent may be subjected to an administrative penalty of up to \$10,000 pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 26.1-01-03.3.

6. According to information received by the North Dakota Insurance Department, during the time period of January 1, 2009, through July 31, 2010, Respondent insured commercial properties inside the platted limits of an incorporated city. Respondent's conduct of accepting applications and premium payments and insuring commercial properties inside the platted limits of an incorporated city constitute violations of N.D.C.C. § 26.1-13-15. For this violation, Respondent may be subjected to an administrative penalty of up to \$10,000 pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 26.1-01-03.3.

7. Respondent has agreed to an informal disposition of this matter, without a hearing, as provided under N.D.C.C. § 28-32-22.

8. For purposes of resolving this matter, without further administrative proceedings, Respondent and Commissioner have agreed to enter into the following Order:

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent is assessed a fine in the amount of \$10,000 which shall be paid within 15 days of the execution of this Order.

2. The use of this Consent Order for competitive purposes by an insurance producer holding a license in the State of North Dakota or by any company holding a Certificate of Authority, or by anyone on their behalf, may be deemed unfair competition and grounds for suspension or revocation of said license or authority.
