WHEREAS, N.D.C.C. § 26.1-01-03(1) requires the Commissioner of Insurance for the State of North Dakota to see that all the laws of the state respecting insurance companies and benevolent societies are executed faithfully; and

WHEREAS, Respondent is an admitted foreign insurance company doing business in the State of North Dakota pursuant to N.D.C.C. Chapter 26.1-11; and

WHEREAS, N.D.C.C. § 26.1-11-08 requires the Commissioner to revoke or suspend all Certificates of Authority granted to a foreign insurance company, or to its agents, if upon examination or receipt of other evidence the Commissioner is of the opinion that the company is in an unsound condition or that the company has failed to comply with any provision of the applicable laws of this state; and

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2000, the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County issued a Verified Complaint and Request for Appointment of Receiver and ordered Respondent be placed into receivership; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2001, Respondent's domiciliary state of Minnesota revoked its license, and all policies were canceled effective January 1, 2001; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2002, the Commissioner entered a Temporary Order Suspending the Certificate of Authority of Respondent based on the Verified Complaint and Request for Appointment of Receiver entered against Respondent; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing information, the Insurance Commissioner of the State of North Dakota is of the opinion that the Respondent is in an unsound condition or has failed to comply with the laws of the State of North Dakota.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Certificate of Authority of Respondent is **REVOKED** in the State of North Dakota.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent shall continue to make all filings and pay fees and taxes as required by the North Dakota Century Code and by any order of the court with jurisdiction over the liquidation proceedings.
