

Introduction Biography for Treasurer Kelly Schmidt

Kelly Schmidt was elected North Dakota State Treasurer in 2004 and re-elected in 2008 with 61% of the vote.

In 2009, Treasurer Schmidt was named a “Toll Fellow” by the Council of State Governments for her achievement and service to state government.

Recognized by her peers as a national leader, Schmidt served a one year term as President of the National Association of State Treasurers (NAST) in 2011. She is also past Chair of the NAST Foundation, a non profit organization supporting the educational initiatives of NAST.

During her tenure as Treasurer, she has worked to bring efficiencies and cost savings to the state government. She is a member of the State Investment Board, Teachers Fund for Retirement, University and School Lands Board, Tax Equalization and the State Historical Board.
