Instructions To Sampler

Sampling Seed For Final Certification

- A. Seed for Bulk Certification – Each bin is a separate lot, limited only to the size of the bin. Only one representative sample of each bin need be submitted.
- B. Seed for Bagged Certification – All seed lot should be sampled if possible during cleaning. The Maximum lot size for bagged seed is 2,000 bushels, except for small seeded legumes and grasses, which is 22,500 pounds. For all crops, one sample for each lot is required. Each lot of seed, bulk or bagged, should be identified by a different lot number. Do not use the same lot number of the seed source planted.

Sampling Bagged Seed

When bagged seed is sampled, a seed sampling probe or bag trier should be used. For a bagged seed lot, a minimum of five bags plus ten percent of the number of bags in the lot up to a maximum of thirty probes should be drawn.

Sampling Seed in Bulk

The best way to sample bulk seed is to draw samples regularly during conditioning and bulk them together for a representative sample.

If the seed is in bulk, trucks, or other large container, a probe should be used to draw the sample from random positions and depths to make up the necessary quantity of seed for the sample.

Size of Sample

The official sample bag must be filled to the top of the bag.

Sampler's Report

The sampler's report should be filled out, signed and placed in the mailing pouch on the side of the official sample bag prior to filling.

As soon as the sample has been placed in the sample bag, it should be securely sealed. Do not allow anyone to examine or tamper with the seed in this sample bag.
