Purchasing Federal Property

ND Surplus Property transfers property from the federal government to your organization for a minimal shipping and handling fee.

All types of property are available for purchase and include: machine tools, appliances, medical supplies, hardware, clothing, motor vehicles, boats, textiles, and construction equipment.

Only certain organizations are able to purchase federal property. State agencies, political subdivisions, ND universities, tax funded organizations like fire departments, ambulances or schools, and some health and education non-profit organizations may qualify to purchase federal property from ND Surplus Property.

To find out if you are eligible to purchase federal property from ND State Surplus Property visit our website www.nd.gov/surplus and submit the Eligibility Application form.

Purchasing State Property

ND Surplus Property also receives property from various state agencies wishing to dispose of their property. They are able to turn around and sell this property to other state agencies, donees, or the public for fair market value.



Anyone is eligible to purchase items received from state agencies and you do not need to fill out an eligibility form to purchase a state item. ND Surplus Property accepts cash, check, and credit cards.
