The 1033 Program

Under Section 1033 of the National Defense Authorization Act of 1996, Congress authorized the Secretary of Defense to transfer personal property that is excess to the Department of Defense (DoD) to Federal and State Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs). This was formerly known as the 1208 Program.

Transfer Conditions:

- Property must be excess to the DoD.
- Property must be suitable for use by Law Enforcement.
- Preference given to counter-drug and counter-terrorism activities.

Who Can Participate?

Federal and State LEAs who have compensated officers with the powers of arrest and apprehension may apply for participation. LEAs with emphasis on counter-drug and counter-terrorism missions are given preference when allocating property.

There have been nearly 17,000 participants in all 50 states and four U.S. Territories since 1995.

STATE

- State LEAs must request enrollment through their State Coordinator.
- The State Coordinator will verify eligibility and either approve or disapprove the Application for Participation and forward approvals to LESO.
- If LESO approves, they will send a Letter of Authorization to the State Coordinator who will forward it to the LEA.

FEDERAL

- Federal LEAs will contact LESO directly to request enrollment.
- LESO will review the Application for Participation. If approved, LESO will send the Letter of Authorization back to the Federal LEA.

How to Enroll?

- LEAs must request enrollment through their State Coordinator (SC), Alan Brinkman.
- The SC must submit approved request to LESO.
- LESO will review request and send approval letter to SC.



Property Screening

- LEAs must appoint an official to screen for property for their agency.
- Screening can take place by visiting the local Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office or electronically via the internet.
- Once property is identified, the request is submitted to the SC electronically via the internet (preferred method) or on a manual DRMS Form 103.
- The SC will approve or disapprove property request.
- Once approved, the property request will be sent to LESO for final approval.
- LEAs receive the property "as-is" condition and the LEAs are responsible for transportation and cost.
