**AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY TO THE CITY
OF MINOT AND EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY OF THE
CITY OF MINOT.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINOT:

Section 1. The city limits of the City of Minot are hereby extended to include as a part of the property contained within the corporate limits of the City of Minot, the following described property:

✓ **MADC 1st Addition, adjacent street rights of way of 59th, 64th, and 72nd Streets SE, and all highway right of way of U. S. Highway 2 from the east right-of-way line of 55th Street SE (existing City limits) to the east right-of-way line of 64th Street SE.**

Section 2. This property is currently zoned General Commercial District. Any development of this property shall be in accordance with the provisions as set forth in the City of Minot Zoning Ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
